General Meeting Agenda:

Tom gave a detailed review of the new accounting process / excel sheet.
Currently account is off by \$2.00 – the board wanted to boil him in oil.
MBRC has \$ 5,200.00 in the account before the Classic.

1) LOYF PROGRAM – Chris Robinson; Director

Off-season effort – time to follow up (stencils) To follow up with the Owen Mc Carthy and the Beach Dept to get stencils in place.
Off season pickup of the garbage - Larry denoted an effort to back up in maintaining the cans by the club / removing them when a storm comes. To be discussed with council members next.
Need approval to buy 12 more signs to be mounted to seasonal beach dog signs (600.00) - **Need vote. Approved**
Need to establish monthly expenditures for trash pick ups for offseason.
Any reports needed for the Manasquan Bank Grant? **No – a written overview for the program efforts will be submitted out of gratitude. Other towns and counties are interested in expansion of the program. BD to re-price package and post it.**

2) 1st Annual Soft-Board Rodeo Contest - **Great event!!**

Suggest the beneficiaries of this event be Manasquan Rec. and Manasquan Elks.

Did we ever pay Manasquan Rec. for the movie night?

NO – but we never received a bill either.

Discussion on the need to represent our club to the community by being detailed in handling Q&A and registration - the 1st event was rough there – Need a trained staff to handle registration

Overall the Friday call was perfect. May consider doing 2 of these next year.

Bruce will be following up on finding about 50 ft speaker wire for the sound system – he will also enquire about the sound system within the Rec Gym for the next movies night.

BOD approved obtaining 75ft speaker cables - but who was doing this???

Voted to have the Membership table set up at the entrance of the beach to entice membership and answer questions – Adam Holloway

Raffles? Y/N? (we have the photo Joe Troger donated and signed T-shirt)

Other items are welcome - selling tickets on the beach. The picture donated by Joe Troger is a 275.00 picture – effort to make as much for the picture.

Trophies – Larry Schmidt Sr. / B&B Trophy / recognition of founders plaques

Larry Sr is making surf boards as trophies – 14\$ each for 24 plus the medals for 3rd through 6th finishers

Plaque board dimensions coming from Bob D. / B&B

(ordered brass plaques for past winners from B&B)

Requested a location to place these trophies – they remain in my basement...fermenting.
